14-16 October 2017

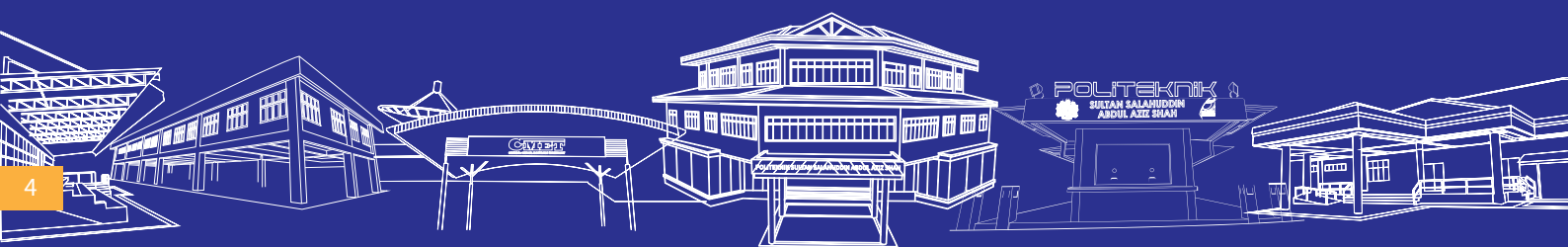

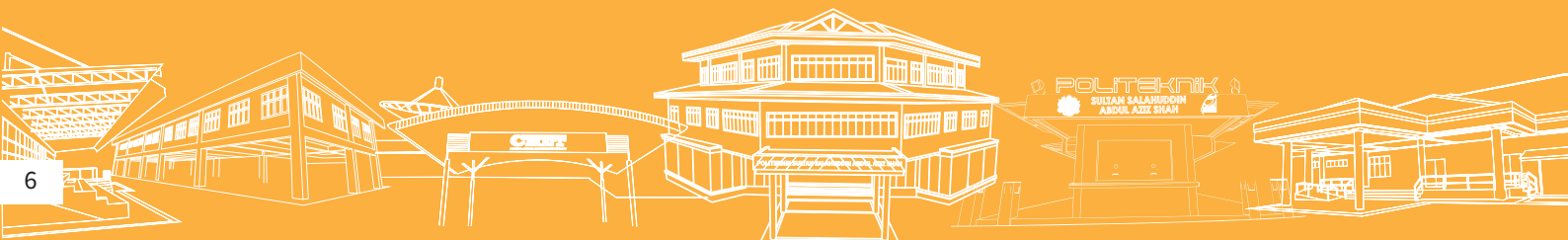

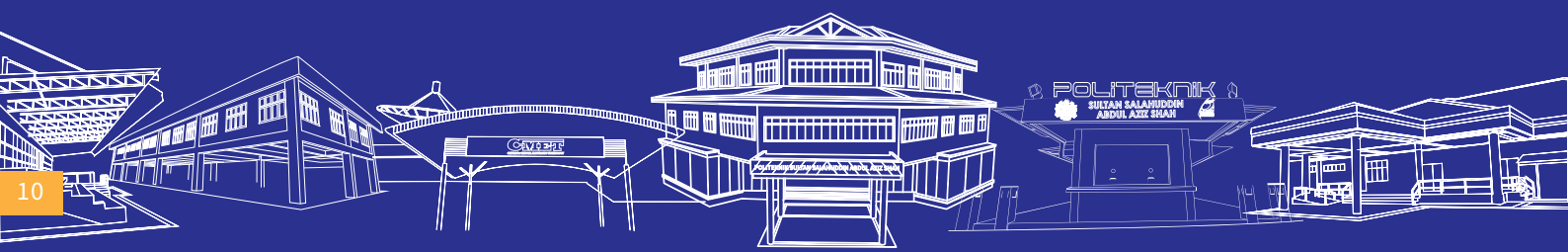
